GLOSSARY OF EXAM BOARD CODES

For each subject you need to check that all the codes shown here appear on your Statement of Entry

GCSE/FC = Full Course

GCSE/B = module: either written exam (“Board Timetabled”) or Controlled Assessment/Coursework/Orals/Performance (“Not Timetabled”)

Suffixes: H = Higher F = Foundation P = Paper (as opposed to on-screen)

“Certification Code” (sometimes called “The Award Code”) means “add my unit marks together to give me a grade”. It is not an actual exam, but it is essential for you to get a grade. Check it is there! Unfortunately it does not always appear in order with its constituent units on the Statement of Entry, but the Certification Codes are grouped together for each Board.

All subjects are now linear, meaning all units are entered this Summer. This includes any Controlled Assessment Units whose marks will be added to those of your written exams. These CAUs are shown as “not timetabled” on your Statement. Although the exams are now linear, the old modular structure has remained for now, hence these complicated codes! The exception is the Maths we do, which has always been linear.

In **French and German** Listening and Reading both tiers are shown on the detailed version of your statement. Your teacher will discuss this with you and tell you which tier you are doing nearer the time. You do not do both! Speaking shows “moderated” or “unmoderated”: this refers to the marking method-ignore!

BTEC exams are dealt with separately and do not appear here.
