## Year 13 Key Stage 5

### Teacher Prediction

This is the teacher's prediction of the grade that the student is most likely to achieve at the end of their Sixth Form studies. The prediction is based upon everything that the teacher knows about the student; their work to date; their approach to the subject; the course content; and the performance of similar students historically at Tring School.

### A2 or BTEC Target Grade

This is the grade the student is targeted to achieve at the end of their Sixth Form studies. It is provided by the Alis system operated by Durham University. Targets are based on the performance of similar students nationally and we would expect a number of students to exceed these targets at the end of their studies.

### Year 13 Examination Result (Spring Term)

This is the grade that the student achieved in the Mock Examination, taking account of any coursework or controlled assessments already completed.

**AS/A2 Grades are:** A\* (not at AS level), A, B, C, D, E, and U

**BTEC Grades:** Distinction\* (D\*), Distinction (D), Merit (M), Pass (P) and Fail (F)

The colour coding on the report compares a student's current Predicted Grade to their Target Grade.

The student is working above their target grade

The student is working at their target grade

The student is working one level below their target grade

The student is working two or more levels below their target grade



### Notes

For students taking an AS course the highest pass grade available is A, even though the target grade for A level may be A\*.

### Attitude to Learning

Attitude to Learning scores are given in relation to Classwork, Homework, Behaviour and Organisation. Scores are from 1-4 for the first three categories and 2-4 for Organisation.
